This month, Massachusetts has already seen grassroots activism at the State House on Temporary Protected Status (TPS) and the Safe Communities Act (take action [here](#)), a \$15/hr minimum wage (take action [here](#)), fossil-free fuel (take action [here](#)), and gun violence prevention (take action [here](#)).

Especially in months like these, progressives need to band together and focus -- and by focus I mean we have to focus on winning the 2018 primary election, which is only 16 short weeks away.

Why do we need money? Here are 3 reasons:

- 1. Reaching Voters at Home:** We have an amazing group of volunteers who are committed to introducing Becca to voters and sharing her progressive agenda through [calling and canvassing](#), and Becca talks to voters one-on-one every single day. But ours is a huge district, and to make sure we reach every voter, we need to get our message into their mailboxes. We need your help to build an effective mail campaign that will bring Becca voters to the polls on September 4, and again on November 6 -- and each primary mailing costs nearly \$4,500.
- 2. Securing Endorsements:** Becca has already been [endorsed by national organizations](#) including NAGE/SEIU and Run for Something, and has earned the Moms Demand Action For Gun Sense Candidate Distinction. Dozens of other progressive organizations are also poised to endorse Becca, reinforcing her values and credibility and making her stand out from the other candidates. For example, Becca was [endorsed by Steve Grossman](#), former Massachusetts State Treasurer and Chair of the Democratic National Committee, along with a host of local leaders. It takes a tremendous amount of staff time to secure these endorsements, and because we're committed to paying our team a living wage, that makes them expensive -- but critical to winning on election day.
- 3. Family-Friendly Campaigning:** Becca is an experienced working mom who, as State Senator, will fight for policies that support children, families, and older adults. Our campaign events and activities are open to all ages, and to ensure that everyone can participate, we provide childcare, healthy snacks, and activities for kids. Your support helps us continue to live our values in this campaign.
